



RJN Provides Computer Management System to Anne Arundel County

The system must also provide specific asset management capability

Anne Arundel County originally retained RJN Group, Inc. to provide a computer management system and modeling and maintenance for the county's sanitary sewer system. The sewer system consisted of approximately 1,000 miles of sewer lines and was expanding rapidly.



In 1991, Anne Arundel County upgraded the existing software to RJN's CASS WORKS® Infra-structure Management Software. Five years' worth of data from the RJN CASS Sewer System Software was converted.

At this time, the Public Works Department of Anne Arundel County is working with RJN to convert multiple Work Management Systems to the CASS WORKS Infrastructure Management System. The required system must provide functionality to control, administer, plan, and document the maintenance services. This includes specific handling of Service Orders (emergencies, repairs, trouble calls), Work Orders (repairs, minor construction), and Preventive Maintenance. The system must also provide specific asset management capability for infrastructure.



The system will be used by the Department of Public Works for the day-to-day support of Asset Management Maintenance, and operations activities for the Bureaus of Utilities, Engineering, Waste Management, and Highways and Parks.
