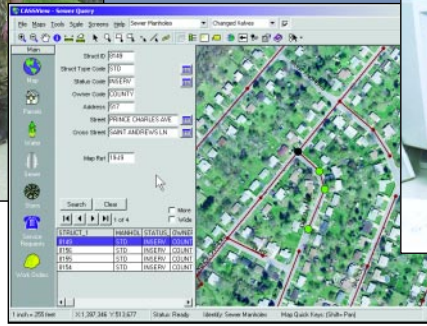

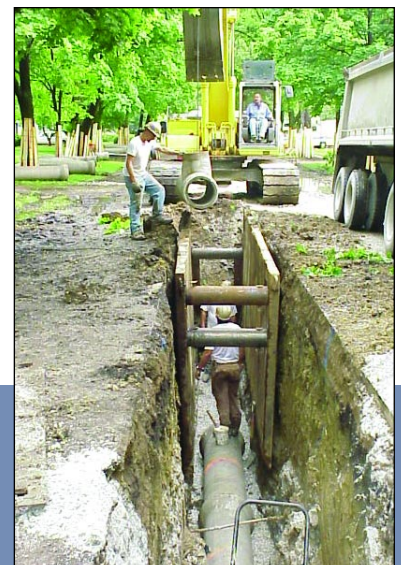

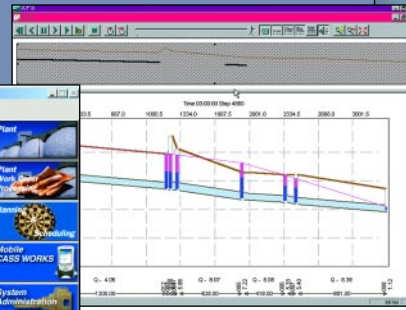
Regulatory Compliance

Capacity, Management, Operation and Maintenance (CMOM)—The U.S. EPA has proposed legislation to clarify the prohibition of Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs) and NPDES permitting for collection systems. The regulation mandates the proper management, operations, and maintenance of all parts of the collection system. All municipalities must assure sufficient capacity to minimize sewer overflows and establish procedures for documentation, public notification, record keeping, and reporting.

Stormwater, Phase II—The U.S. EPA has issued the Phase II stormwater regulations requiring municipalities to implement programs and practices to control polluted stormwater runoff. Documentation must be submitted outlining control practices for the detection, elimination and enforcement of illicit stormwater runoff.

GASB 34—The Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) has published on how state and local governments must account for the value and condition of their infrastructure assets in annual financial reporting. Municipalities must document sound decisions to maintain adequate infrastructure, as their public assets age. Though there are no penalties for non-compliance, bond ratings could be affected.

Fiscal Support

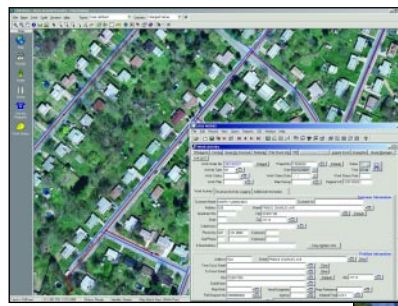
