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RJN Group, Inc. Selected for Lea Ann Way West and Lantana Pump Station SSES

Wheaton, IL (January 13, 2010) – RJN Group, Inc. (RJN) was recently selected by the Louisville and Jefferson County Metropolitan Sewer District to perform a full-scale sewer system evaluation survey (SSES). The project will include evaluating, identifying, and quantifying sources of infiltration/inflow (I/I) for the Lea Ann Way West and Lantana Pump Station study areas. RJN will identify, propose, and prioritize recommendations to reduce the amount of I/I entering the collections systems of the two study areas. RJN will conduct public meetings to educate residents on the work being performed. Fieldwork will consist of 1,372 manhole inspections, smoke testing 313,966 linear feet of pipe, dye tracing/flooding, performing closed-circuit television on 265,475 linear feet of pipe, wet-weather inspections, and private property inspections. Data collected will be analyzed for final reporting and recommendations to the client. The project will be completed in December 2010.
