The nominated projects ranged in terms of goal, size and price—from \$350,000 to \$300 million. The WWD editorial staff selected winners based on the types of challenges faced and overcome in the course of the project, as well as final goals achieved and success met. The projects will be featured in the December issue of WWD.
